8. The 'Gloria'

The 'Gloria' is a very old prayer of praise and thanksgiving. The first few lines will sound familiar because it was the song sung by the angels when Jesus was born in Bethlehem. The 'Gloria' is not used during the seasons of Advent and Lent.

9. Opening Prayer

After the 'Gloria' the priest invites us to pray. The prayer begins in silence. This gives us time to talk to God in our hearts. We might want to thank God for something good that has happened or we might want to ask God to take care of something that is worrying us. Then the priest takes our prayers and offers them to God. The Opening Prayer differs from Sunday to Sunday. We respond by saying 'Amen'. 'Amen' means that we believe that whatever God does is okay with us.
